Citizen's Police Academy

SEPTEMBER 11, 2014 - NOVEMBER 13, 2014

Introduction

The FHPD Citizen's Police Academy is presented to adults, 21 and over, who live or work in Fairview Heights. People from outside the City may be accepted, but the residents and workers of the City will be given preference. This program is a combination of presentations, tours, and hands on experiences intended to give the citizen a better understanding of modern policing in a local context.

Some portions may require physical activity. The Department and staff will work to make reasonable accommodation to individuals with special needs.

When: Each Thursday from Sept. 11th to Nov. 13th

Time: 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. each evening

Tentative Topics – Introduction • **FHPD Tour** • FHPD History • Criminal Law • Identity Theft • **Firearms Range - *Hands on Experience** • Illinois Vehicle Code • Crime Free Multi Housing • Domestic Violence • **Police Canines** • School Resource Officer • Drugs & Narcotic Enforcement • Driving Under the Influence Presentation • **Active Shooter- Hands on experience** • Field Sobriety Testing- Hands on Experience • Use of Force • **Taser Demonstration** • Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted • County Jail Tour • **SWAT Team demonstrations** • High risk encounters- Hands on experience • Graduation

*Firearms Range is not for concealed carry permit qualification or for concealed carry training

Each participant will also complete a **4 hour ride along with a patrol officer**, to be scheduled outside of the regular training. There will also be many opportunities for question and answer sessions.

What to Wear/ What to Bring

- Participants should wear business casual clothing. Shorts may be acceptable. No open-toed shoes, please. Some hands on experiences may require special clothing.
- Participants will be informed in advance of any need for special clothing.
- Participants just need to show up ready to have fun! We will provide a notebook, pen or pencil, and any handouts. Cameras are welcome, if you want to take your own photos of your experiences.
- Refreshments will normally be made available, including water, soda, coffee, and snacks.

\$25 Deposit Fee

A \$25 deposit fee will be required for each participant. This fee will be refunded upon completion of at least 70% participation in the program. This refundable fee is to promote attendance and participation, as there may be others who were put on a waiting list.



Yard Sales:

Residents may have up to 3 yard sales per calendar year & those sales must be at least 30 days apart. A Permit is required for the sale & must be obtained in advance. In the event of inclement weather, all permits will remain active and an alternate date will not be made available.

Prohibited from such merchandise to be sold at yard sales shall be alcoholic beverages, firearms, firearm ammunition, materials determined by the City Code as obscene, animals, or any other merchandise of which sale without proper licensing or authorization from state or local authorities is unlawful.

Neighborhood/Group Yard Sales must contact the Land Use Dept for specific regulations in advance of sale. Regulations include, but are not limited to, a contact person responsible for the sale, list of all participating residents including names, addresses, phone numbers and signature. One Permit will be issued for all listed participants of the neighborhood/group sale.

School Registrations:

As many area schools require a valid Occupancy Permit for registration, please take time to verify your Occupancy Permit reflects all current residents. If an update is needed due to birth of a child, you will need to bring a Photo ID for yourself, a copy of the child's birth certificate, and the \$10.00 update fee, to City Hall. In some cases, a housing inspection may be required, and a new Occupancy Permit may be issued. Contact the Land Use & Development Department should you have questions regarding your Occupancy Permit.

Swimming Pools:

A public or private swimming pool in any zone district shall not be located in any required front yard, nor less than 10 ft to a side lot line adjacent to a street. All swimming pools of more than 2 ft in depth shall have an obstacle of at least 4 ft in height around the pool and it may be a fence or other approved obstacle.

Additionally, all swimming pools of more than 2 ft in depth shall require a building permit PRIOR to placement of the pool. Contact the Land Use & Development Dept for more information on placement, permits and required obstacles.

Fairview Heights Senior Center

The Senior Center is the place to call regarding the use of the Fairview Heights Senior Center which is located in the lower level of the main city hall building located at 10025 Bunkum Road.

Throughout each month there are several senior citizen activities such as senior aerobics and luncheons.

The Senior Center, on those weekdays or weekday evenings when it is not being used for a senior citizens activity, is also available to Fairview Heights for club meetings, birthday parties, receptions, or other non-business related gatherings at no charge, just a \$50 deposit. ***The Senior Center is closed on weekends.***
