Staff met on May 11 with the City's consultant who presented the final report on the Fox Creek Drainage Study. Information will be relayed to Committee at the meeting. An informational meeting with an open house format is scheduled for Thursday, May 28 for citizens to review the study's findings and further discuss with staff.

- 4) **Surplus Vehicles**

Staff requests permission to sell three city vehicles for which bids were received and opened on April 30. (Bid Tabulation attached)

- 5) **Project Updates**

- A) IL 159 / I-64 Enhancement Project – The contractor is regrading slopes and adding top soil in areas that need to be reseeded and will proceed to assess and replant perennials and shrubs as necessary. The contractor has also started mowing and weeding operations.
- B) Richmond Drive – The bridge structure is 95 percent complete with only the wearing surface and bridge rail to be completed. At present, Ameren is on site relocating their infrastructure. The contractor will then return to the project to install storm sewer and proceed with curb, gutter, and pavement.
- C) Greenridge Heights Road – A final inspection was conducted and the contractor will return to complete punch list items.
- D) Perrin Road – Storm sewer installation began on May 13 which should be complete in approximately two to three weeks. Subsequently, road excavation will begin and installation of curb, gutter, and pavement.

- E) City Hall Front Entrance – Material submittals have been reviewed and approved with exception of the handrail which is being revised and will be resubmitted for review. The project will commence four weeks prior to the delivery date of the handrail. Therefore, the project will be scheduled to begin upon notice from the contractor of the delivery date of the handrail.
- F) South Road - Because the scope of this project is extensive, the City has received three bids to complete the storm sewer system installation which will alleviate the drainage issues at the Durkee residence.
- G) Lincoln Trail Sidewalks – Final plans and specifications were received by this department earlier this month. Review was completed and the project will be bid early June.
