The regular meeting of the Fairview Heights City Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Mark T. Kupsy in the City Council Chambers, 10025 Bunkum Road, Fairview Heights, IL and also remotely due to the COVID19 Pandemic with the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation by City Clerk Karen J. Kaufhold.

**ROLL CALL**

Roll call of Aldermen present: Aldermen Pat Peck, Anthony LeFlore, Bill Poletti, Frank Menn, Josh Frawley, Barbara Brumfield, Brenda Wagner and Harry Zimmerman. Alderman Denise Williams was absent. Alderman Ryan Vickers attended virtually. City Clerk Karen Kaufhold and Attorney Garrett Hoerner were present.

Department meetings have taken place with the Mayor and Department Heads, the Finance Department is compiling all of the information into the budget format.

## Sales Tax

Sales Tax report for March is attached. Sales Tax continues to surpass prior year numbers. The Sales Tax figures received in March are collected by the state in January, but reflect December sales. The Sales Tax was 8.1% lower (\$9,245.61) than the same month in the prior year. Year-to-date Sales Tax exceeds last year by \$87,804.08.

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 01-'23**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 16, OF ORDINANCE NO. 190, "THE REVISED CODE," CHAPTER 16, FEES AND SALARIES, ARTICLE I - SALARIES, AND ESTABLISHING A NEW ARTICLE I SALARIES; AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS, IL 2022-2023.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. SALARY RANGES. Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Salary Ranges for Non-Contract Full Time employees; Non-Contract Part Time employees – per hour; Non-Contract Part Time Recreation Complex employees – per hour and certain appointed officials are attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked "EXHIBIT A."

SECTION 2. PAY. Pay shall be paid in full for the amount due no later than the fifth (5) day of the following month. The Finance Department shall calculate and establish the hourly rate based on the monthly base pay as approved in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. CHRISTMAS BONUS. In addition, each full time employee shall receive a \$150.00 Christmas Bonus. Said bonus will be paid on the first payday in December, and will be paid by separate check. To be eligible for a Christmas bonus, the employee must have completed at least twelve (12) months of continuous full-time service prior to December 1<sup>ST</sup> of the year in which the bonus is paid.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY EMPLOYEE. Emergency employees shall be paid in an amount equal to the base rate for the type of work they are doing.

SECTION 4. REPEAL. Article I – Salaries of Chapter 16, Fees and Salaries, of Ordinance No. 190, "The Revised Code," is hereby repealed from the date of passage and approval of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. PASSAGE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
