

**CITY OF FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS
CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
FEBRUARY 15, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Fairview Heights City Council was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Mark Kupsky in the Recreation Room, 10025 Bunkum Road, Fairview Heights, IL and also remotely due to the COVID19 Pandemic with the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation by City Clerk Karen J. Kaufhold.

ROLL CALL

Aldermen Pat Peck and Frank Menn were present. Alderman Harry Zimmerman was absent and excused. Mayor Mark Kupsky and City Clerk Karen Kaufhold were present. Attorney Andrew Hoerner attended virtually.

Proposed Resolution No. 8-'22 passed on 9 yeas and 1 absent. Proposed Resolution No. 8-'22 now becomes **RESOLUTION NO. 4419-2022.**
