

The regular meeting of the Fairview Heights City Council was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Mark Kupsy in the Recreation Room, 10025 Bunkum Road, Fairview Heights, IL and also remotely due to the COVID19 Pandemic with the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation by City Clerk Karen J. Kaufhold.

ROLL CALL

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed Ordinance No. 4-'22, an Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 190, "The Revised Code", thereby creating Chapter 7 – Building Code and repealing Sections 14-3-1 through 14-3-7, Sections 14-11-2 through 14-11-4, and Sections 14-11-7 through 14-11-8 of Chapter 14 – Development Code. Motion by Alderman Wagner. Seconded by Alderman Poletti. Proposed Ordinance No. 4-'22 was read for the first time.

Alderman Peck moved to amend Proposed Ordinance No. 4-'22 by adding the changes which were presented at the Community Committee meeting. Seconded by Alderman Wagner.

Roll call on the amendment showed Aldermen Poletti, Williams, Menn, Frawley, Brumfield, Wagner, Zimmerman, Peck, Vickers and LeFlore voting "Yea." Motion passed on 10 yeas and no nays.

Alderman Vickers arrived at 7:14 P.M.

Proposed Ordinance No. 5-'22, an Ordinance establishing a budget for the City of Fairview Heights for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023. Motion by Alderman Wagner. Seconded by Alderman Williams. Proposed Ordinance No. 5-'22 was read for the first time.

Alderman Poletti moved to amend the proposed budget total amount to \$31,881,392.00. seconded by Alderman Peck.

Roll call on the amendment showed Aldermen Poletti, Williams, Menn, Frawley, Brumfield, Wagner, Zimmerman, Peck, Vickers and LeFlore voting "Yea." Motion passed on 10 yeas and no nays.

Proposed Resolution No. 11-'22, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with United Health Care and Guardian Insurance Company for the provisions of group medical, dental, vision and life insurance coverage for employees of the City of Fairview Heights effective May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023. Motion by Alderman Peck. Seconded by Alderman Brumfield.

Roll call on Proposed Resolution No. 11-'22 showed Aldermen Poletti, Williams, Menn, Frawley, Brumfield, Wagner, Zimmerman, Peck, Vickers and LeFlore voting "Yea."
Proposed Resolution No. 11-'22 passed on 10 yeas and no nays.

Alderman Peck moved to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Poletti. Motion carried.
